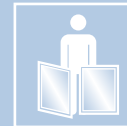
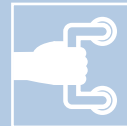
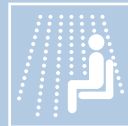
This Policy applies to all Procare operations.




POLICY STATEMENT

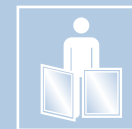
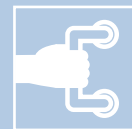
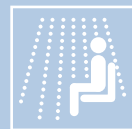
Pro Care will continue to recognise and exercise its responsibility to:
